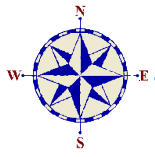

Sat. Nov 21

USA to Naples

Depart USA airports for your overnight flight into Naples, Italy, for your week long vacation!

Sun. Nov 22

Naples – Sorrento

Upon arrival at the Naples airport, transfer to our hotel in Sorrento. Depending on your flight arrival time, the balance of the day is at leisure to start exploring this interesting city with its great shopping and coastal location. However, make sure you are back in time for our welcome get together early evening. Dinner is at leisure to meet your new travel companions.

The Sorrento Coast is known for its terrace gardens, mountains with steep cliffs and amazing villas that have been attracting visitors from all over the world for 200 years. Sorrento, on the coast, is a small city in Campania, Italy, and is a popular tourist destination. It overlooks the bay of Naples and has many views of Naples across the bay and Vesuvius. Sorrento is very popular because of its' good location to all the surrounding sights in the area as well as its' gorgeous vistas and cliffs.

Sorrento and the Amalfi coast are known for their wonderful big lemons. Products from Sorrento are produced with these "Limoni" such as Limoncello, a very tasty lemon liqueur; lemon chocolate; colorful ceramic articles with lemon motives or lemon soap. Other agricultural production includes many citrus fruit, wine, nuts and olives. Also Sorrento is known for its' hand made ceramics and wood craftsmanship which includes some beautiful in-laid pieces. Enjoy!

Mon. Nov 23

Sorrento -Amalfi Coast

Today is a full day to enjoy our guided drive on one of the most famous and beautiful coastal areas in the world-the Amalfi Coast-with views of Positano, Amalfi and Ravello. The Amalfi Drive (connecting Sorrento and Amalfi) is a narrow road that winds around the high cliffs above the Mediterranean. The Amalfi Coast is on the southern side of the Sorrentine Peninsula of Italy and extends from Positano to Vietri sul Mare. The Amalfi Coast is listed by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site and is known for its rugged terrain, scenic beauty, picturesque towns and diversity

During our drive we will visit the town of Amalfi which lies at the mouth of a deep ravine and is surrounded by dramatic cliffs and coastal scenery.

Also see Ravello, a peaceful, historic village popular with tourists and it is one of the most attractive destinations on the Amalfi Coast with a population of around 2,000. It is perched high above Amalfi, overlooking the Mediterranean and is famous for its views and gardens. The town has served historically as a destination for artists, musicians, and writers.

Positano is the most vertically scenic of the villages along the coast and has come from a artists' colony and poor fishing village to an upscale resort. The main part of Positano sits in an enclave in the hills leading down to the coast. It began to attract large numbers of tourists in the 1950s, especially after John Steinbeck published his essay about Positano in *Harper's Bazaar* in May, 1953. Today tourism is the major industry in Positano.

After our full days' journey, we return to Sorrento and dinner is at leisure to enjoy some Italian cuisine and wine with friends from the group. Maybe then we can find some local nightlife? **(B)**

Tue. Nov 24

Sorrento at Leisure

Today we have a full day at leisure to enjoy Sorrento on your own or with friends from the group. We have listed many interesting things to possibly do for the day in the area, but make sure you research and discover things you may want to do in and around Sorrento on our free day. Explore, hike, shop.....it's your free day to see this beautiful area up close!

Things to do in and around Sorrento:

You could take a ferry boat or hydrofoil to the famous Isle of Capri- a breathtaking area of natural beauty in the Bay of Naples. Maybe go hiking in the nearby hills to see the breath-taking ocean views and vistas that surround Sorrento.

Or you can visit the many attractions in town such as:

--Chiesa di San Francisco-A 14th Century Monastery that features a fine cloister with arches and gardens set in the midst of the busy resort town.

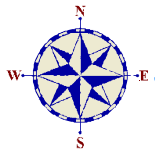
--Museo Correale di Terranova- has ancient sculpture and antiques housed in a former palace. A highlight is the local art of intarsia, using wood to make thin, nearly flat figurines.

--Antiquarium Aequano- a archeological museum with a collection of finds from the Etruscan and Greek periods.

--Duomo (Cathedral of Sorrento)- The outside is whitewashed and does it no justice at all, inside the building is beautiful, the ceilings and the altar are very impressive.

Wed. Nov 25

Sorrento – Rome via Pompeii

This morning we depart after breakfast for Rome via motor coach. We'll enjoy a stop at Pompeii for a visit to these very famous ruins of the city that was destroyed, and completely buried, during a catastrophic eruption of the volcano Mount Vesuvius spanning 2 days in 79 AD.

Rome (*Roma*) is Italy's capital, and the country's largest and most populous *comune*, with about 2.7 million residents. It is located in the central-western portion of the Italian peninsula. Also called "the city of the seven hills", it is modern and cosmopolitan but central Rome is very Renaissance and Baroque in character, as it was one of the few major European cities that escaped a lot of damage in World War II. The Historic Centre of Rome is listed by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site.

After getting settled into our hotel in Rome, start exploring and enjoying this fascinating city. Dinner at leisure tonight with friends from the group and maybe enjoy an evening walk and a glass of red Italian wine. **(B)**

Thur. Nov 26

Rome

After breakfast we have a half day guided tour of the Vatican, including entrance to the Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel, and St. Peter's Basilica.

The Sistine Chapel ceiling, painted by Michelangelo from 1508 - 1512, is one of the most famous artworks of the High Renaissance and the beautiful St. Peter's Basilica is inside the Vatican City. The Basilica's dome is prominent in the Roman skyline and is one of the largest religious buildings in the world and is often used by the Pope.

Vatican City is a landlocked sovereign city-state within the city of Rome. It is the smallest independent nation in the world and is ruled by the Bishop of Rome, the Pope, and it is the Pope's official residence.

Your afternoon is at leisure...so much to see and do in Rome! **(B)**

Fri. Nov 27

Rome at Leisure

Today we will have a chance to enjoy a full day at leisure in Rome. Maybe take an optional tour with others from the group or just enjoy the main sights by starting early in the morning and exploring with a few others from the group.

While in Rome you have many options on how to spend your day and below are some suggestions.....

-The Colosseum, from AD 72, is world-renown, and is where gladiators met in combat and prisoners fought lions.

-Take a stroll through Rome's historical center, where you can admire sights such as the Trevi Fountain. Tradition has it that throwing a coin over your left shoulder into the fountain guarantees a return to the world's most beautiful city.

-Visit the Pantheon (visit inside to see the building's sole source of light-it is the opening at the dome's apex).

-See the Piazza Navona-where the Fountain of the Rivers and the Fountain of the Moor are both by Bernini. It's a great area for people watching and enjoying lunch or dinner.

-Visit or sit and people watch at the most famous Spanish Steps which lead up to the Chiesa di Trinità dei Monti.

-Rome is also a great place for shopping with designer outlets and department stores all over the city. Do some shopping near the Piazza di Spagna (Spanish Steps) and then the square leads into several famous streets, Via Dei Condotti, Via Frattina and Via Borgognona with their luxurious boutiques, and Via Del Babuino with its antique shops. This street is one of the richest streets in Italy and one of the best streets for shopping and people-watching in Rome. The Via Dei Condotti sports designer stores such as Armani, Prada, Versace, Dolce and Gabbana, as well as Gucci and other well-heeled notables. This is also the street where the shop owners used to charge you just for walking in the door! Thankfully these days all of the shops sport an "ingresso gratuito" sign which means you can go in and look around without any obligation to buy.

Dinner is at leisure-a farewell dinner can be arranged for our last night in Italy! **(B)**

Sat. Nov 28

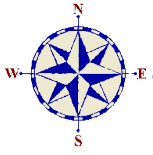
Depart Rome for the Home

Airfare is additional and you need to fly **into Naples, Italy (NAP) and out of Rome (FCO) Airports.**

We will be trying to coordinate air flights so we can do 2-3 group transfers on arrival into Naples and 2-3 group transfers on departure out of Rome. Please let us know your flight schedules as soon as possible or we can book your air flights and we will be trying to coordinate flights together for the transfers.

Flight times and airports to qualify for \$25 each way transfers:

Arrival-Naples Airport—arrive between 9am-3pm.

Departure-Rome Airport---Departure between 6am-12 noon.

Airport Transfers- \$ 25 each way (\$50 roundtrip). We will be coordinating 2-3 group transfers on arrival and departure (depends on the times of flights and best times for the transfers-see above), so if you want to be included there may be a little wait on either end. If you want to do your own transfers the price will be higher, especially from Naples to Sorrento on arrival....it is 90 minutes to Sorrento.

Travel Insurance- Travel Insurance is highly recommended-information available upon request.

Passport- A valid U.S. passport is required for travel and should be valid up to 6 months after date of travel.

Non-U.S. citizens please check your consulate for required passports or visas needed for travel.

Price does not include- Tips and gratuities to drivers and guides, meals not included in the itinerary, items of a personal nature, phone calls, travel insurance, and transfers if not taking group air flights.

After airline tickets are issued, airline cancellations are per the airline's policy/ and or the tour operator if purchased through the tour operator and tickets are usually non-refundable.

Travel insurance is highly recommended in case you have to cancel due to illness.

Dear Traveler

Thank you for your interest in Singles Travel Company. We have domestic and international trips and cruises for the single traveler to every corner of the world! We are a national group that caters to singles from across the U.S. and Canada, as well as singles from around the world.

We are a travel agency, not a tour operator, specializing in advertising and promoting travel for singles to enjoy traveling together on trips around the world. We are affiliated with a travel agency--Travel Advisors of Los Gatos-- that has been in the same location with the same owner-Ed Stahl--for over 40 years.

Since we are not a tour operator, we contract with tour operators who are responsible for the organization and execution of our trips and cruises. The tour operators and cruise lines we use are professional group travel specialist, this is their area of expertise, and they are totally responsible for the operational aspects of the trips we advertise for our singles. We are proud of the tour companies we have chosen for our trips—they are specialists in their region of the world and are travel industry leaders for their destinations.

Singles Travel Company is under the supervision of Ann Thomas, a leader in the singles travel industry. As Founder and President of another national singles travel group, and with many articles written about her and her company, she brings 18 years of experience with the unique singles market to Singles Travel Company. Her and her staff strive to bring you quality and top value vacations. We get a lot of repeat travelers on our trips, some traveling 6-8 times with us, and we value their loyalty and confidence.

Our mission is to bring you as perfect a vacation as possible and one that will give you wonderful, lasting memories and new friendships.

The following information is general information only; refer to each trip's complete itinerary for the fine print for that particular trip. Your payment for a tour or air ticket is regarded by Singles Travel Company /Travel Advisors of Los Gatos as an agreement to the General Terms and Conditions listed here as well as the Fine Print at the end of each individual trip itinerary. **Please read all information and call with any questions.**

Deposits and Final Payments. A deposit and a signed reservation form is required within 7 days of your reservation. Final payment due dates are listed on each trip and are usually 65-90 days prior to departure. Without full payment & your reservation form; final travel documents cannot be sent to you.

Late Bookings. Payment is due in full and within 48 hours of your reservation if you make your reservations after final payment due date.

Tour Documents. Tour documents are sent about 10 days prior to trip departure. A fee may be added if documents are requested earlier.

Cancellation, Revision Fees, Refunds.

These fees vary with each trip offered; please read the fine print with each itinerary as the fine print on the individual trip itineraries will override the following cancellation penalties. For any cancellations made 91 days or more prior to the land trip date, a full refund of the land trip deposit will be provided, less a \$50 cancellation fee from Singles Travel Company on ALL cancellations--this fee will be charged to your credit card. Cancellations must be in writing. No partial refunds on package tours for unused services or features. If events beyond our control force us to alter your vacation arrangements, we do not accept liability. Any refund as a result of any alteration or cancellation caused by events beyond our control will be limited by the amount paid to us. We cannot accept any responsibility for any affect on clients resulting from any event beyond our control. If a tour is cancelled, all monies will be refunded; however, we cannot assume responsibility for any additional costs or any fees relating to the issuance and/or cancellation of air tickets or of other travel arrangements made in regard to the cancelled tour. Processing a refund can take 6-8 weeks. **Travel insurance is highly recommended.**

Travel Insurance. This is an insurance policy that covers you if you need to cancel your vacation plans for medical reasons after you've paid money on the trip. If you decline trip cancellation insurance for a

cruise or tour and cancel your plans for any reason after the specified period of leeway, chances are that you won't get a refund. Therefore, we, and our tour operators, highly recommend cancellation insurance. We have information on travel insurance and many tour/cruise operators offer their own protection policies. Some policies offer lost luggage reimbursement, medical coverage, etc. Make sure you know what qualifies as an acceptable reason for cancellation (personal or business conflicts usually do not) and read all the fine print before signing. Processing your claim can take 6 weeks or more. If you have a pre-existing medical condition you can be covered for travel insurance but you usually must purchase the insurance with your trip deposit.

Airfare. Land only prices are quoted on most trips, so you may use your frequent flyer miles. When using your frequent flyer miles or not flying on the inclusive group air packages quoted; transfers are not included in the tour package and you must make your own way to the first night's accommodation. Airfare prices are based on availability at time of booking and are subject to change until fully paid for and ticketed. We will attempt to get all requested seat assignments but we are limited to airline availability and requirements. Air tickets once issued are non-refundable but sometimes changeable with a fee and are always subject to the airline's cancellation penalties, which may be different than our land cancellation fees. Airfare taxes/fuel surcharges are subject to change without notice and any increases will be passed on to the client.

Prices. Prices are per person based on double occupancy unless otherwise noted. To save you money, roommate matching is available with same sex roommates if you sign up prior to final payment. Single supplement prices are available. **We reserve the right to change pricing in the event of any cost increases for operational requirements.** Any changes to the tour itinerary that incur additional charges will be the sole responsibility of the passenger. We reserve the right to alter prices at anytime prior to final payment date and without prior notice if circumstances so warrant. The tour participant is responsible for proper travel documents; any needed visas or immunizations for travel, and for providing the correct passport name to the travel reservationist. Any devaluation or revaluation of foreign currencies may affect the printed prices. In case of human or computer error, we reserve the right to re-invoice for the correct price of service.

Hotels. Hotels are subject to change per our tour operators and are usually out of our control as hotels do overbook. Most hotels used are moderate to first class or 3-4 star properties; twin-bedded with private bath. Single room accommodations outside of the U.S. are usually a single bed in a much smaller room, and sometimes are not as spacious or in the same area of the hotel as the double occupancy rooms. Hotel rooms, especially in Europe, are often older, smaller, and less equipped than the American equivalent & are much higher priced during peak travel seasons. Sometimes standards and service in hotels around the

world are not what we are accustomed to, but is all part of the adventure of travel and exploring the world.

Baggage. One suitcase is allowed on tours, two for cruises. A smaller bag for carrying on the buses should not exceed 17" x 14" x 18" and should not be wheeled carry-on cases. Airlines have their own restrictions and are imposing limits and fees on luggage. No responsibility is accepted for loss of or damage to baggage or any of the passengers' belongings. Baggage insurance is highly recommended and can be purchased with travel insurance.

Not Included in the Tour Price.

Airfare, airfare taxes & fees, fuel surcharges, security fee; airport departure fees, passports; visas; tips to the tour director, tour driver, and local city guides; gratuities on cruise ships; laundry, beverages & food not on regular included table menu, optional excursions; and all other items of a personal nature.

Roommates. After the final payment due date of 2-3 months prior to a trip date, we can't guarantee a roommate assignment; get your deposit in early to avoid disappointment. We cannot guarantee the compatibility of roommates. We will attempt to match individuals as to age & smoking/non-smoking status, but this cannot be guaranteed. Smoking is not allowed on buses or in shared rooms/cabins unless agreed upon by all occupants of the room. Any expenses after the tour departs for single room accommodations are at the traveler's expense.

Passports and Visas. A valid passport is required on international tours and must be valid up to 6 months after your trip dates. For tours requiring visas for U.S. citizens, detailed visa information will be given to you. Non-U.S. citizens must consult with their appropriate consulates to determine if any visas are needed. Securing any needed visas is the responsibility of the tour participant.

Medical. The traveler is responsible to check with his private medical doctor, local county health agency, or travel medicine clinic for any necessary or precautionary medicines, shots and immunizations required for travel.

Group Travel Responsibilities. We reserve the right to cancel, reschedule, or change any trip or tour itinerary that does not meet the minimum requirements to operate and/or is deemed necessary for operational requirements and we are not responsible for any other expenses incurred by the client in relation to the trip being canceled, including non-refundable air tickets. Most group trips will have a Singles Travel Company social host/representatives along on the trip, and/or a professional tour director. Our social hosts/representatives are responsible on trips

as hosts only, and to assist in making sure the group runs smoothly and cohesively (they are not professional guides). They do not represent or replace professional tour guides used on some trips nor do they represent or replace our tour operators' responsibilities. While on tour please address any concerns to the tour operator or cruise line while on your tour or cruise and to our staff (if one is assigned to the trip) so that they can address the situation at the time. Notify our company after the trip of any concerns so we may follow-up and address any issues with the tour operator also. We reserve the right to not send a social escort from STC on a trip if we have less than 15-20 singles on the trip. We cannot assume responsibility for any actions of travelers on our trips and we do not screen our travelers. We operate many types of trips, so make sure you are aware of the type of trip you are signing up for. Some trips are bus tours with professional guides and may be incorporated with other larger group tours. **Most of our singles tours are all singles** but a few may be incorporated with another tour operating **WHICH MAY OR MAY NOT BE SINGLES**-this ensures a guaranteed departure. Most trips are guaranteed departures and will depart no matter how many singles are on the trip. We cannot be held responsible for the number of singles participating on any group trip and we cannot guarantee the number of singles on our trips, nor the ages or ratio of men to women. Special diet and dietary restrictions cannot be guaranteed.

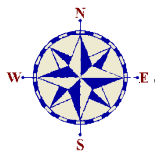
Travelers Who Need Special Assistance. Most of our trips require lots of walking, so you should expect to walk a minimum of several blocks at a time on uneven pavement with some uphill walks and stairs. It is your responsibility to be aware of your limits in the above group settings and with the activities listed in the trips. Any disability requiring special attention must be reported to us at the time the reservation is made. We will make reasonable attempts to accommodate the special needs of disabled tour members, but we are not responsible in the event we are unable to do so, and we are not responsible for any denial of services by carriers, hotels, restaurants, or other independent suppliers. Most touring motor coaches are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. We regret that we cannot provide individual assistance to a tour member for walking, dining, getting on and off motor coaches and other transportation vehicles, or other personal needs. A qualified companion must accompany travelers who need such assistance.

Responsibilities. The carrier, hotels and other suppliers providing tour services are independent contractors and are not agents, employees or servants of joint ventures with Singles Travel Company (hereafter referred to as "STC."). "STC" is not responsible for any changes to any itinerary by our tour operators or cruise lines. We reserve the right to

revise any included features of a trip. All certificates and other travel documents for tour services issued by "STC" are subject to the terms and conditions specified by the supplier and to the laws of the countries in which the services are supplied. If the services included in the tour cannot be supplied or there are changes in an itinerary for reasons beyond the control of "STC", then "STC" will arrange for the provision of comparable services to be provided from their tour operator. Any resulting additional expense will be payable by tour participants. "STC" reserves the right to accept or reject any person as a tour participant, to expel any tour participant from the tour, to make changes in the itinerary whenever "STC" deems it necessary to the comfort, convenience or safety of the tour participants, and to cancel a tour at any time. If it is deemed by the tour operator or guide/host on the trip that it is in the interest of safety or other reasons to ask a person to leave a tour, no refund of any kind will be given to that participant.
