**Barcelona, Spain-** Join us for our prenight in Barcelona to see the main sites and history of this city.

Barcelona is located in the northeastern part of the country, 90 miles south of the French border. When Hans Christian Andersen visited in 1862, he remarked that Barcelona was the "Paris of Spain." The city is a major cultural center with a fascinating history.

#### **Naples/Capri, Italy**

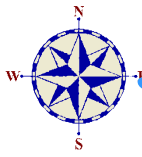
#### **Nice (Villefranche), France**

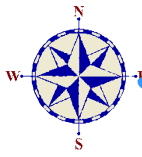

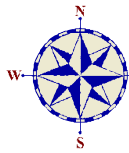
**Deposits are due now (spring/ early summer) for our low group rates.**
